



Sixth Form Area

Exam Season

- There are 367 students in the Sixth form – on average they are doing about 3.5 Subjects each and approx. 2 exams per subject.
- This means that over these weeks there will be 2569 exams being sat.

Sixth Form Centre

- The Sixth Form Centre is a place for students to study and work. Over the Exam Season it is VITAL that it is used for this purpose only.
- All students need somewhere quiet to focus, study and revise.
- At the moment this is not always the case and this needs to change.
- The teachers and staff that oversee this area during school time and after school are there to ensure that this is the case.

Sixth Form Centre

- Students must respect their peers' need for a space in which to study undisturbed.
- Students must work quietly downstairs and in silence upstairs.
- No phone conversations upstairs.
- No food or drink upstairs.
- Non-academic conversations need to take place out of school at this time.
- Students who don't follow these expectations and the basic rules that are on display will be given a warning. If it continues then they will be asked to leave, parents will be contacted and they will face a ban from the sixth form centre.
