- ✓ **Adolescence** - Puberty, mental health and wellbeing
- ✓ **Risks** - Being safe, safer internet passwords, sexual health, substance misuse
- ✓ **Challenges** - Independence, over protective parenting
- ✓ **Tactics** - Stop / Search role plays, Body Worn Video cameras
- ✓ **Issues that Concern Parents** - Cyber bullying, gangs, sexual activity and drugs

## Key Aims of the Events

To reinforce the Safer School Police Officers role as a key point of contact for students who need help and support from the Police. In addition we can signpost to other organisations and agencies. We promote good attendance, investigate incidents of crime, reduce crime and fear of crime in and around the area of the schools. This includes reducing bullying, street crime, victimisation of young people, raising awareness of police and the law for young people, initiating and supporting diversionary practices where possible.
