Gather a range of inspiring visual information to inspire design development

Explore a variety of different materials and techniques and develop your own textile response based on your investigations

Summer work -

- 1. Brainstorm the theme
 - Paragraph on the theme and what element you will focus on
- 2. Gather images, drawings, postcards, photos and create a visual brainstorm or mood board
- 3. Research TWO artists/designers/textiles artists, ensure these are relevant the focus you have chosen.
 - 3+ images (large) of their work that reflect the architecture theme
 - Discuss at least one of the images in detail, link it back to your focus
- 4. **Extended drawing or photography** try to work in different mediums to sketch or photograph subjects relating to the theme
- 5. Visit and exhibition or museum

All of the work above needs to be completed and presented in an A3 sketch book or on A3 sheets for your first Textiles lesson in September.
