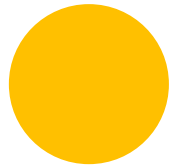
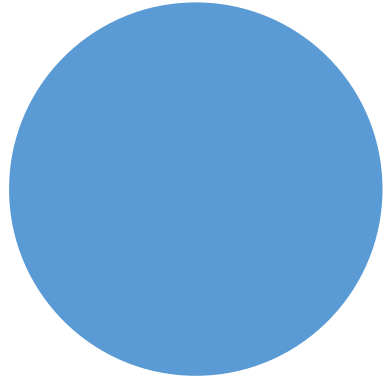

The Working Week

- Tap in and out with swipe card
