English	4	Mon & Wed	On Mondays, students will be set the equivalent of two lessons / tasks with the aim that these should be completed by the Wednesday. On Wednesdays, the same will be set again to complete by the end of Friday. The work that will be set will always be part of an overall topic for that half term, just like we would do at school. And just like at school, you'll be developing your reading and writing skills to help you feel more confident when you have a go at completing an extended piece of writing at the end of the topic. We expect students to try their best and not to panic if they find any of the work hard. You can contact your class teacher by writing a comment on SMHW. We also encourage all of you to challenge yourselves to read as much as you can for entertainment!	For the work that is set on Mondays and Wednesdays, students should try their best but should not panic if they can't do it all. Photos of work or word documents can be uploaded for your teacher to see on SMHW so that they can say 'well done!' There will also be two main pieces of work across the whole half term (topic) that your teacher will mark with a WWW (what went well) comment, and an EBI (even better if..) comment. Maths	4	Mon & Wed	Four maths tasks on Hegarty Maths will be set per week to cover lessons and homework. Two tasks will be set on a Monday, with a due date of Wednesday and two will be set on a Wednesday, with a due date of Friday. These four tasks will appear as just two SMHW entries each week. Students will be expected to upload photos of work completed onto SMHW as well as answer the relevant quizzes on Hegarty Maths. Science	3	Mon	Every Monday, a task will be posted on SMH relating to a year 7 or year 8 topic. The task will refer to the Activate Text book (the relevant pages of which have been scanned) and/or to BBC Bitesize. Students will need to submit the work by the Friday of that week on SMH.
