English	4	Mon & Wed	On Mondays, students will be set activities which should be completed and submitted via Show My Homework on the Wednesday. On Wednesdays, English work will be set again for the Friday. The work that we set will always be part of a broader unit of study, just as we would do in school. Twice per half term, there will be opportunities to do pieces of work which class teachers will be giving more detailed feedback for (a specific 'What Went Well' and 'Even Better If'. We look forward to adding work which students have been able to do from home to their English books/folders when we eventually return to school, and encourage students to contact their teacher via Show My Homework if they have any questions. For Summer Term 2, Year 10's are studying Poetry for their Literature GCSE (AQA) and learning will be supplemented by 'guided lessons' on the Monday where their class teacher will use audio to help pupils through the PowerPoint resources.
