

Half term	Unit Title	Description
	<u>Baseline</u>	Recap of writing skills to prepare students for baselines assessment.
	<u>Novel</u>	A half-term scheme of work during which students will read and study 'Coraline'. Students will read for engagement and enjoyment and focus on how the author crafts character.
7.2	<u>Play</u>	A half term SOW introduce students to English at Stoke Newington. During this SOW students will study aspects of A Midsummer Night's Dream and develop their reading skills in particular the use of quotations. The SOW is designed to aid the transition between KS2 and KS3 and to help students cope better with their transition to secondary school. Students also practise their spoken English skills and the whole year group is involved in a performance of A Midsummer Night's Dream.
7.3/4 This SOW to be done in shorter half term	<u>Short Stories</u>	A half-term SOW to introduce students to a wide range of short stories, contemporary, traditional and from other cultures. Students will develop their reading and writing skills. The SOW culminates in their own creative writing.
7.3/4 This SOW	<u>Poetry/Coleridge</u>	A half term SOW during which students develop their knowledge of poetry and the literary heritage by studying Coleridge in depth. Students will practise their skills of analysis whilst studying 'The Rime of the Ancient Mariner' in detail.
7.5	<u>Fiction Reading</u>	A half term scheme of work during which students read a range of extracts from coming of age novels. Students will practise their skills on language and structural analysis in line with English Language Paper 1 Section A. Homework tasks will sometimes focus on creative writing to help prepare for Q5 as well.
7.6	<u>Non-fiction writing</u>	A half term scheme of work following the non-fiction reading assessment in which students apply the conventions and features of non-fiction to their own writing.
