9.1	<a href="#">Confectionery Project</a>	Project description: students learn & build on basic illustrator skills from Y8. Illustrator is the software package that will be used predominantly throughout the GCSE - Designing typography for branding: pencil drawings, scanned and developed with CAD. Project tasks: analysis of design brief & mind map/ product analysis of wrappers/ Product analysis of existing products (HW)/ Customer Profile/ Typography practice - using grid (hand drawn and CAD)
9.2	Confectionery Project / Theory content	Print processes research/ print finishes research/ research plan/ design specification develop initial design work using CAD (Illustrator) and net design for wrapper/ Typography development (sketching and CAD)/ confectionery design and modelling (block modelling with styrofoam/clay)
9.3	<a href="#">Confectionery Project / theory content</a>	Developing packaging design - development of nets for wrappers/ Point of Purchase development: design initial sketches of POPs, design nets for 3 chosen designs, modelling/ testing nets - developing final proposal of net
9.4	Confectionery Project / Theory Content	developing drawing techniques - focus on orthographic projection & Isometric drawing. Applying dimensions (BSI)
9.5	Confectionery Project / Theory content	Final Net for POP: draw final design on Illustrator and apply same branding as confectionery wrapper - developing skill with CAD / Illustrator. Writing a manufacture specification - materials & dimensions
