

Half term	Unit Title Hyperlink to SOW	Description
7.1	The Elements of Music (5 Lessons)	Introduce students to the elements of music: melody, articulation, dynamics, structure, instruments, rhythm, texture, tempo through a variety of listening activities.
7.2	Introduction to the Orchestra (5 Lessons)	Introduces students to the orchestral families of instruments including videos to watch extracts to listen to and written activities.
7.2	The Purpose of Music	An exploration through a variety of genres of music in a variety of settings.
7.2	Music for Dance	An introduction to a variety of styles of music for dance across a 400 year period incorporating a range of cultures from around the world.
7.3	Music for Media	Understanding how chords are formed and learning how to play chords on the keyboards and ukuleles.
7.4	World Music, Reggae	Learn about music from different cultures, including Samba, African Drumming, Gamelan, Music from the Middle East etc.
7.5	Introduction to Periods of Music	Learn about music from the Baroque, Classical and Romantic genres.
7.6	Programme Music	Introduction to the romantic tone poem. In the Hall of the Mountain King, Sorcerer's Apprentice, Danse Macabre, Carnival of the Animals, Rite of Spring
