8.1	How far did New World slavery dehumanise enslaved African people?	History of the Trans-Atlantic Slave Trade/Nature of Slave trade/Resistance/Causes of abolition/Hackney's involvement.
8.2	Why was the road to Civil Rights bumpy?	Looking at key individuals and events leading up to the improvement of civil rights in America and Britain.
8.3	World War 2 and The Holocaust	Studying the events of WW2 and the holocaust, including history of antisemitism, resistance and remembrance.
8.4	London Migration	Migration to and from London since Roman times including 19 <sup>th</sup> , 20 <sup>th</sup> and 21 <sup>st</sup> centuries.
8.5	What caused the Industrial Revolution?	Studying the causes, events, and consequences of the Industrial Revolution.
8.6	WW1 and The Suffragettes	Students will look at the causes and events of WW1, and the British Suffrage movement, looking at key figures such as Emmeline Pankhurst and Princess Sophia Duleep Singh.
