GIRLS IN LOVE **JACOUELINE** WILSON Ellie meets nerdy Dan on holiday. He asks her out but Ellie turns



and doesn't want to attract attention. So why does he offer to be the pretend dad to Hannah's unborn baby? Growing up can be trouble but that's how you find out what really matters.




BLACK SHEEP NAIMA B'ROBERT

IF I STAY GAYLE FORMAN Mia, 17, is surrounded by a wonderful family, friends and boyfriend. Her decisions





Teenager Nazneen is forced to marry a much older man and has to move from



* FARENHEIT 451 RAY **BRADBURY** Set in a nottoo-distant future where books are



* 1984 GEORGE ORWFII In the Record Department of the Ministry of Truth, Winston Smith skilfully rewrites the


